TIGERS OUTSIDE ENCLOSURE

Meet at the door of the top tiger viewer where you will receive a safety briefing. You are then taken to den areas where the keeper will talk about conservation status, husbandry and more. Keeper feeds tiger at mesh. *Your friends won't believe the photos!*



CAPUCHINS OUTSIDE ENCLOSURE

Meet at the capuchin monkey exhibit where you will receive a safety briefing. You are then taken to the enclosure where the keeper will talk about husbandry, conservation status and more. Keeper assists guests to safely feed capuchins through mesh. *Keep your camera at the ready!*



CHEETAH OUTSIDE ENCLOSURE

Meet at the top savannah viewer. You'll be taken to the cheetah service area and given your safety briefing. Cheetah are brought into the yard where the keeper will talk about husbandry, conservation status and more. *Another great photo opportunity, but be quick - cos these guys are!*



RING-TAILED LEMUR INSIDE ENCLOSURE

Meet at the tamarin enclosure for safety briefing. You'll be taken into the enclosure where the keeper will talk about husbandry, conservation status and more. *They're cute and ready to play so have your camera ready.*
